### **NOTICE INVITING STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS MATERIALS TESTING AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE NORTH BARLOW/DIXON LANE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT INYO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA**

The Inyo County Public Works Department is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from engineering firms to provide material testing and inspection services for the North Barlow/Dixon Lane Improvement Project.

The North Barlow/Dixon Lanes Improvement Project is located in Bishop, California. The scope of work for construction of the project generally consists installation of crack-sealing material on Dixon and Saniger Lanes; installation of a hot mix asphalt leveling course on Dixon Lane; the installation of a 2-inch thick hot mix asphalt overlay on Dixon and Saniger Lanes; cold in-place recycling (pulverization of existing asphalt concrete pavement) and the installation of 3 inches of new hot mix asphalt on North Barlow Lane; the installation of Portland cement concrete ADA ramps on Barlow Lane at the intersection of Bar L, Bar M, Silvercreek and Shoshone Lanes; and installing shoulder backing (imported material).

The anticipated materials testing and inspection services for this project include compaction testing of reconstructed base (pulverized asphalt concrete); sieve, sand equivalent, and, if needed, percentage of crushed particles and durability index testing of imported shoulder backing material; testing of emulsified sealant for crack sealing; and quality assurance testing of hot mix asphalt according to the requirements of the new Section 39 of the Caltrans Standard Specifications.

The successful candidate firm must be licensed to provide civil engineering services in the State of California. The firm must have documented experience with materials testing for federally funded programs. If your firm has this experience, and you are interested in receiving the Request for Qualifications (RFQ), which describes the projects in more detail, please fax a request to the Inyo County Public Works Department (760) 878-2001.

It is the intent of the County to evaluate all proposals received in response to the RFQ. To be considered, SOQs must be received before 5:00 PM on September 18, 2009 at the Inyo County Public Works Department, 168 N. Edwards Street, P.O. Box Q, Independence CA 93526.
