Parolee at Large Arrested

Parolee at large, Anthony Andreas, was arrested without incident on Saturday. Inyo County Special Enforcement Detail, consisting of a specially trained unified team of Bishop Police officers and Inyo County Sheriff's deputies and investigators rushed the Primrose Lane Apartments mid-morning Saturday after a victim claimed she had, among other heinous acts, been held at knife point.

"Andreas has been considered a parolee at large since December 2008. Due to the scope of this case, we knew it had the potential of going either way. The Special Enforcement Detail that Inyo County has is staffed with top-notch professionals, and Andreas was taken into custody without incident," stated Sheriff's Sergeant Jeff Hollowell.

Andreas was booked into the Inyo County Jail on the following felony charges: criminal threats, attempted rape, burglary, false imprisonment, domestic battery, assault with a deadly weapon and parole violation. Andreas is currently on a parole hold, with bail for local charges at \$100,000.
