PROGRAM GOAL

The goal of the Drinking Driver Program is to assist persons participating in the program to recognize the existence of an alcohol problem and to provide a treatment environment to facilitate individual recovery, and to reduce the incidents of drinking drivers in the State of California

THE DRINKING DRIVER PROGRAMS ARE OFFERED TO:

- Provide an approved and licensed program for the treatment and education of First Offender and Multiple Offender drinking drivers.
- Provide a means by which the clients may fulfill judicial stipulations relative to issues surrounding "driving under the influence" convictions.

INYO COUNTY IS LICENSED TO <u>PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING</u> <u>PROGRAMS:</u>

- The Wet and Reckless Education Program (W&R) for clients arrested with less than a .08 Blood Alcohol level (BAL)
- The First Offender Program (FOP) for clients arrested for the 1st Driving Under the Influence (DUI) offense with BAL between .08 and.20.0.
- The First Offender Program .20 (FOP2) for clients arrested for their 1st DUI with a BAL .20 or higher.
- The First Offender Program .20/9 months (FOP2/9mo.) for clients arrested for their 1st DUI with BAL greater than .20.
- The Multiple Offender Program (MOP) for clients arrested for multiple DUI offenses
