It is my pleasure to submit to you the 1979 AGRICULTURAL CROP REPORT as required by Section 2279 of the California Food and Agriculture Code.

Inyo-Mono farmers and ranchers produced food, feed, and fiber from the land with an estimated valuation of \$19,404,739 in 1979. This was a considerable increase over 1978 amd was due mainly to increased prices paid to local producers for cattle and alfalfa hay. It must be remembered that the values in this report represent gross returns only and do not reflect net income.

Alfalfa brought good returns, especially late in the year when supplies were insufficient to meet demand. Yields were up slightly. Potatoes, a new crop in 1979, were produced in the Oasis area.

Cattlemen received the best prices in many years for cattle with a slight increase in numbers sold.

A special word of thanks goes to all who assisted with the preparation of this report, especially P. Dean Smith, Inyo-Mono Farm Advisor, and George Milovich, Agricultural Inspector.
