

Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure

THREE STEPS



Got a needle stick or other sharps injury?

Exposed to blood or other potentially infectious material?

STEP 1: FLUSH

- Flush splashes to nose, mouth, and skin with water
- Irrigate eyes with clean water or saline.

STEP 2: WASH

- Wash needle sticks and cuts thoroughly with soap and water.

STEP 3: REPORT

- Immediately report the incident to your supervisor to make sure you get the care you may need and handle the required documentation.
