• 5 confirmed COVID-19 cases | 0 deaths

Inyo County Testing:

- Tests Administered: 83 (NIHD & Toiyabe)
- Tests Positive: 5
- Tests Negative: 61
- Tests Pending*: 17
 *Cases with pending results are monitored by medical staff ordering test; Inyo County Public Health monitors pending results identified as high probability individuals.

Local Information, Action, & Recommendations

- Inyo County Public Health Order: Inyo County Public Health Officer issued a Public Health Order on March 27th identifying self-isolation and quarantine measures including:
 - All individuals who have been diagnosed with or who are likely to have COVID-19, including those who have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results, must isolate themselves.
 - All household contacts, intimate partners, caregivers, and close contacts who have been in close contact with a person diagnosed with or likely to have COVID-19,

including those who have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results ,must quarantine themselves.
