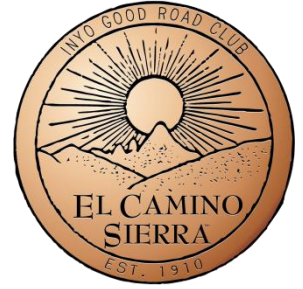

Inyo County Cases:

- 19 confirmed COVID-19 cases | 1 death | 15 recovered

Inyo County Testing:

- Tests Administered: 530 (NIHD, SIH, & Toiyabe)
- Tests Positive: 19
- Tests Negative: 499
- Tests Pending*: 12

**Cases with pending results are monitored by medical staff ordering test; Inyo County Public Health monitors pending results identified as high probability individuals.*
