- Total Tests Administered: 584 (NIHD, SIH, & Toiyabe)

- Tests Pending*: 12

Local Information, Action, & Recommendations

- **Inyo County Fishing Opener - Update:** The Inyo County Board of Supervisors submitted a request to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife on May 26th requesting that Inyo County's fishing opener, previously scheduled for June 1st, be moved forward. It is our expectation that the CDFW will release a statement tonight with a new Inyo County fishing opener date of May 28th.
