## **Local Information, Action, & Recommendations**

- Inyo County Fishing Opener Update: The Inyo County Board of Supervisors submitted a request to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife on May 26<sup>th</sup> requesting that Inyo County's fishing opener, previously scheduled for June 1<sup>st</sup>, be moved forward. It is our expectation that the CDFW will release a statement tonight with a new Inyo County fishing opener date of May 28<sup>th</sup>.
