- 19 confirmed COVID-19 cases | 1 death | 18 recovered

#### **Inyo County Testing:**

- Total Tests Administered: 597 (NIHD, SIH, & Toiyabe)
- Tests Positive: 19
- Tests Negative: 563
- Tests Pending\*: 15  
*\*Cases with pending results are monitored by medical staff ordering test; Inyo County Public Health monitors pending results identified as high probability individuals.*
