Inyo County Testing:

- Total Tests Administered: 597 (NIHD, SIH, & Toiyabe)
- Tests Positive: 19
- Tests Negative: 563
- Tests Pending*: 15 *Cases with pending results are monitored by medical staff ordering test; Inyo County Public Health monitors pending results identified as high probability individuals.
