### **Local Information, Action, & Recommendations**

- Inyo County 20<sup>th</sup> Positive: Inyo County's Public Health Officer, Dr. James Richardson, received notification this morning from Northern Inyo Healthcare District regarding one new positive COVID-19 case for an Inyo County resident. The current total of positive COVID-19 cases in Inyo County is now at 20. Inyo County Public Health is working to determine the source of the infection and is conducting investigations to identify potential exposures and notify contacts. At this time the patient is currently isolated at home in the greater Bishop area.
- CRITICAL REMINDER Failure to comply with Health Officer Orders places individuals and our community at increased risk of infection. Violation of Health Officer Orders may also result in a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment, fine, or both (Health and Safety Code §120295).
