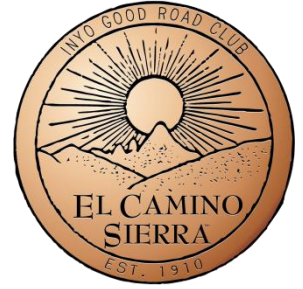

- 24 confirmed COVID-19 cases | 1 death | 18 recovered

Inyo County Testing:

- Total Tests Administered: 855 (NIHD, SIH, & Toiyabe)
- Tests Positive: 24
- Tests Negative: 813
- Tests Pending*: 18
**Cases with pending results are monitored by medical staff ordering test; Inyo County Public Health monitors pending results identified as high probability individuals.*

Local Information, Action, & Recommendations

- **Inyo County Situation Update:** Effective today, Monday, June 15th Inyo County Situation Updates will be issued on a weekly basis every Monday. All confirmed positive testing numbers will be updated each business day on the Inyo County COVID-19 Response banner, which is viewable from www.inyocounty.us, and critical information will be released as a Press Release. - **2020 Fireworks Show Modifications:** After abundant consideration from Public Health and in consultation with the Bishop and Independence Volunteer Fire Departments, the fireworks shows in Bishop and Independence for 2020 will be modified to be “Stay at Home Shows.” This means that no central viewing areas will be provided or available. - **Lone Pine Verily COVID Testing:** Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Lone Pine COVID -19 testing scheduled to take place on Friday, June 19th has been rescheduled to take place on Thursday, June 18th and testing will not take place at the Bishop site that day.
