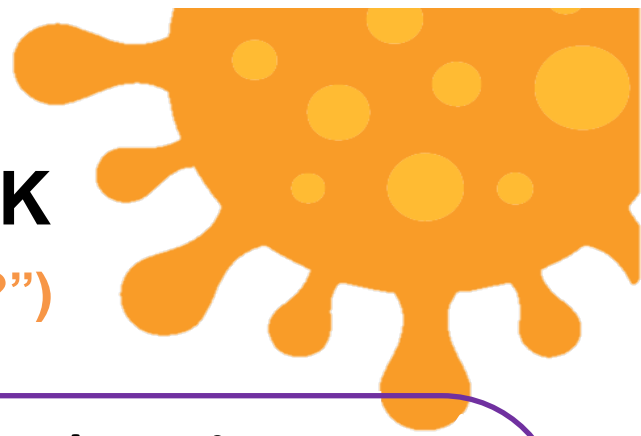


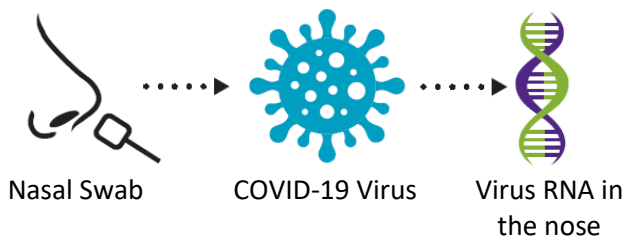
# HOW CORONAVIRUS DIAGNOSTIC TESTS WORK

(aka “Do I have/Did I have COVID-19?”)

## Nasal Swab Testing (aka “PCR”)

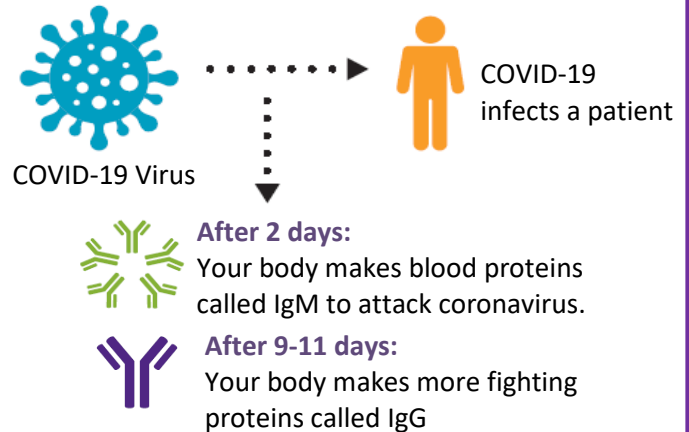


**Nasal swabs directly detect the virus**

**Only test approved to diagnose current COVID-19 infection**

**B**

## Blood Testing (aka “antibody”, “IgG/IgM”)



**A positive blood test means the person has been exposed to the virus.**



### How to get Tested

- Talk to your Primary Care Provider if you are symptomatic (testing is available at NIH, RHC, SIH, and Toiyabe)
- **Verily Mobile Testing**
  - Anyone can be tested if they are at least 18 years old
  - **Bishop:** Church of Nazarene parking lot. Available Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
  - **Lone Pine:** Lone Pine Sports Complex. Available every Friday.

### How to get Tested

- Blood testing can only be ordered by your primary care provider for diagnostic purposes at this time. Ask them if you are a candidate to get tested.

  - Individuals who donate blood may also be tested for COVID-19
