Inyo County Cases:

- 46 confirmed COVID-19 cases | 1 death | 40 resolved

Inyo County Testing:

- Total Tests Administered: 2475
- Tests Positive: 46
- Tests Negative: 2149
- Tests Pending: 279

**Data sources include testing totals from NIHD, SIHD, Toiyabe and Verily testing site, as they become available. Positives tests for those who are not full time residents in Inyo County are not included in the Positive Case count. Total, pending, and negative test numbers include individuals tested more than once.*

- **Centers for Disease Control Return-to-Work Guidance:** On Friday, July 17th, the CDC updated guidance for returning to work for COVID-19-positive individuals:

I think or know I had COVID-19, and I had symptoms

You can be with others after:

At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared and

At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication and

Symptoms have improved

I tested positive for COVID-19 but had no symptoms

If you continue to have no symptoms, you can be with others after:

10 days have passed since test
