• **COVID-19 Vaccine Update**: Effective April 15, 2021, vaccine eligibility has opened up to all residents 16 years of age and older with Pfizer being the only vaccine currently approved for those 16 or 17 years old. Many vaccination opportunities are available in Inyo County, please see below for a complete list:

<u>Pfeizer Mass Vaccination Clinic, Lone Pine</u> – Thursday April 29th at Statham Hall from 12:30pm to 3:00 pm. Every one 16 and older is eligible. Minors need parent or guardian consent. Schedule your appointments now at <u>www.myturn.ca.gov</u>

• Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine Updates: On April 24, the Johnson & Johnson vaccine was concluded safe and effective with the benefits far outweighing the extremely rare clotting disorder associated with the drug. The FDA lifted its pause on the use of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine and recommended resuming the vaccine. If you have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, and develop severe headache, abdominal pain, leg pain, or shortness of breath within three weeks after vaccination, contact your healthcare provider, or seek medical care.
