

## INYO COUNTY COVID-19 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS UPDATE May 24, 2021 – 4:00 P.M. https://www.inyocounty.us/covid-19

<u>As California prepares to move beyond the Blueprint for a Safer Economy</u>, we will no longer be issuing these weekly emergency operation updates. Inyo residents can continue receiving updates by signing up for the vaccine mailing list via:

We expect to see very limited measures remain as we get back to a usual way of life. The purple, red, orange and yellow tiers (<u>https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/CDPH%20Document%20Library/COVID-19/Dimmer-Framework-September 2020.pdf</u>) that helped us manage our COVID-19 response are on track to end June 15th. In continued efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19, CDPH strongly encourages the following recommendations for the general public health:

- Everyone should get vaccinated when eligible.
- Indoor spaces should be well ventilated following current CDPH and CalOSHA guidance.

• Everyone should sign up for CA Notify (<u>https://canotify.ca.gov/#section2</u>) to receive alerts when they have been in close contact with a positive case.
