Notes for Minutes:

**Call meeting to order** - Quorum 8:03 A.M.

Mr. Dave Tanksley and Mr. Scott McKenzie were introduced as being re-appointed to the CSA#2 Advisory Committee.

Scott McKenzie made a motion to Approve minutes from last meeting.

**Public Works Report**

1. Plans and specifications to replace the sewer at the end of Sumac Rd. have been submitted to the Forest Service to get approval of free use agreement. Forest Service indicated they have been taking the wrong approach to this situation, and has told Public Works they now intend on issuing a “Temporary Construction Easement”. Inyo County Public Works has re-submitted a Form sf-299, with a narrowed scope, for approval of the temporary construction easement. The Forest Service has indicated that they will not permit the sewer line to be replaced where the line goes under the spring. Committee advised Travis Dean to review the camera footage to see if the dip in the sewer line extends under the spring, and report back to the committee about his findings by email. Forest Service has said we will deal with the renewal of the existing Free Use Agreement at a later date.

## **New Business**

2. Discuss sewer lateral at 281 Columbine Dr. – Aspendell Mutual Water Company (Water Company) is drilling a well. There is currently a sewer lateral that runs through the property acquired by the Water Company, that services 281 Columbine Dr. The Water Company needs to remove and replace, in a new location, said sewer lateral as the sewer lateral is too close to the proposed well. The Water Company is requesting assistance from the County to help with discussions with the State. Dan Totheroh said he would reach out to the State to see about abandoning the lateral rather than removing it.
