COVID-19 EXPOSURE

- Schools may provide general exposure notification to school community when there is a high level of risk of any infectious disease.
- Students with known exposure to COVID-19 should follow exposure guidelines for general public.

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

- Symptomatic students should wear a mask and be tested for COVID-19 immediately.
- Symptomatic students should not return to campus until feeling better and 24 hours have gone by without fever and without the use of fever-reducing medication.
- Students and staff who test positive should follow the general public guidance.

- No person can be prevented from wearing a mask unless wearing a mask poses a safety hazard.
- Masks are a highly effective and inexpensive tool for mitigating transmission of respiratory diseases.
