Road Status 03/12/2024

- 1. Schober Lane will be TEMPARALY CLOSED and under construction from 03/18/2024-03/22/2024. Construction crews will be replacing a culvert. Please access Browns Town from Hwy 395.
- 2. North Lake, and Sabrina Lake roads Closed for Annual winter closure. We do not foresee reopening until springtime.
- 3. South Lake Rd CLOSED, above Habeggers, for Annual winter closure. We do not foresee reopening until springtime.
- 4. Horseshoe Meadows Rd CLOSED, for Annual winter closure, at the gate. We do not foresee reopening until springtime.
- 5. Whitney Portal Rd CLOSED, for Annual winter closure, at the gate before the switchbacks. We do not foresee reopening until springtime.
- 6. Onion Valley Rd CLOSED, for Annual winter closure, at 7 Pines. We do not foresee reopening until springtime.
- 7. Upper Rock Creek Rd Closed due to snow in the area.
- 8. Furnace Creek Rd. is CLOSED, from Old Spanish trail Rd. to Tecopa Hot Springs Rd., due to flooding. Please drive with caution as County Road crews may be running equipment.
- 9. Newman St., south of Big Pine, CLOSED, from Stewart Lane to Butcher Lane. The flood bypass channel water crossing suffered extensive damage. No anticipated opening date currently.
- 10. Mesquite Valley Rd heading to Old Spanish Trail Rd and Charleston View is OPEN. Mesquite Valley Rd heading towards the San Bernadino County line is CLOSED, due to the flooding from the Storm Hilary. It has washed out many water crossings. No anticipated opening date currently.
- 11. Cottonwood Rd. Closed at the Cottonwood Powerhouse Rd. intersection just west of HWY 395 to the end of the road. Three stream crossing culverts were washed away during flash flooding and the dirt road suffered extensive damage with the road washed out in multiple places. No anticipated opening date currently.
- 12. South Saline Valley Rd. The road is closed from Hwy 190 in the south to Hot Springs turn off. Flash flooding has caused multiple washouts of the dirt roadbed near Bat Rock. No anticipated opening date currently.
