

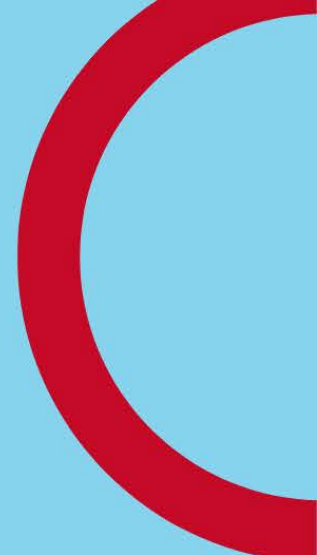
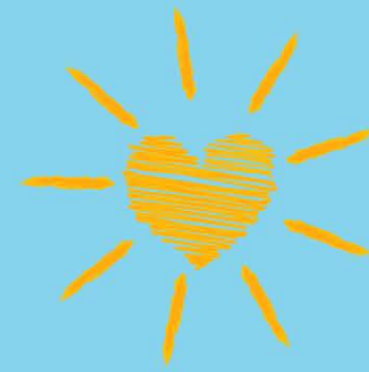
VISION & MISSION
