Inyo County is submitting the ATP Corps Consultation Form to CCC and CalCCC for review. The Connecting Tecopa: Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Corridor ATP project will install multi

use paths connecting Tecopa Heights with Downtown Tecopa and Tecopa Hot Springs along Old Spanish Trail and Tecopa Hot Springs Road. The commercial zone of Tecopa Hot Springs will incorporate sidewalks and class II bike lanes. Wayfinding and gateways signs will be installed at the endpoints of the project. Pedestrian refuges will be installed to calm traffic and provide safe crossing opportunities ahead of the downtown and commercial zones.
