CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION COUNCIL

PURPOSE: Pursuant to Section 18980, et seq. of the Welfare and Institutions Code (also known as the Child Abuse Prevention Coordinating Council Act), the purpose of the Inyo County Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC) is to coordinate the community's efforts to prevent and respond to child abuse and neglect.

ESTABLISHED: 2022

- COMPOSITION: The CAPC shall consist of a minimum of five (5) members, but no greater than eleven (11) members, as determined by CAPC bylaws and represent the following sectors: public child welfare services; public or private schools; medical and mental health providers; criminal justice system; Tribal representation; Latinx representation; prevention and treatment services; community representatives, volunteers, civic organizations, religious communities; and parent or primary caregivers. Anyone with an interest in, and commitment to, improving child abuse prevention and intervention services in Inyo County may apply to be a non-voting "community advisory member."
- TERM: Two-year terms.
