## INDIAN WELLS VALLEY GROUNDWATER BASIN JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

- PURPOSE: The Indian Wells Valley Groundwater Authority is tasked with developing a groundwater sustainability agency by June 2017 and a groundwater sustainability plan by January 2020 for the Indian Wells Valley Groundwater Basin, per the mandates of the State Groundwater Management Act.
- ESTABLISHED: Established through a Joint Powers Agreement approved in 2016 (on July 12, 2016 by Inyo County)
- COMPOSITION: Consists of five general members: Kern, Inyo, and San Bernardino counties, the City of Ridgecrest, and the Indian Wells Valley Water Director. Inyo County's membership one member of the Board of Supervisors and the Water Director was approved by Board Order on July 26, 2016. The alternate was changed to County Counsel John Vallejo on January 5, 2019.
- TERM: Annual appointments by the Board of Supervisors.
