

TRIBAL CONSULTATION COMMITTEES

PURPOSE: To consult with Tribes on various matters in a consistent, efficient, and culturally suitable manner.

ESTABLISHED: Pursuant to the Inyo County Tribal Consultation Policy adopted on October 11, 2016.

COMPOSITION: Two members of the Board of Supervisors assigned to each Tribe in Inyo County. Under the Policy, the County's stated preference is that each consulting Tribe also appoints at least two members of its Tribal Counsel to serve as its Consultation Committee representatives; however, the Policy also recognizes that each tribe may designate other Consultation Committee representatives.

TERM: Supervisors appointed annually
