CONCEALED CARRY WEAPONS (CCW) TRAINING INFORMATION

Pursuant to California Penal Code Section 26165, you must successfully complete a course of training approved by the Inyo County Sheriff's Office for the issuance of a CCW permit. You are not required to complete/pay for any training prior to the determination of issuance of a CCW permit.

You must provide written verification from the firearms instructor that you can safely manipulate and fire each weapon listed on the application. The Sheriff reserves the right to deny a license for any firearm that has been altered from the manufacturer's specifications or that is unsafe.

For new CCW applicants, a minimum 16-hour firearms training course must be completed. For renewal CCW applicants, a minimum 8-hour firearms training course must be completed. The training completion certificate and qualification must be dated within six months of the good cause notification (before or after). A CCW permit is valid for two years from the date of issuance.
