ITEM 5. Child Abuse Prevention Month Activities Report

April 2025 CAPC Event Summary

In April 2025, the Child Abuse Prevention Council hosted two successful community events to promote awareness and prevention of child abuse.

On **April 25, 2025**, the **Children's Memorial Flag Raising Ceremony** was held at the Clint Quilter Consolidated Office Building. Partner agencies in attendance included Inyo County Health and Human Services, Inyo County Probation, Sierra Life Flight, Bishop Police Department, Inyo County Sheriff's Office, Bishop Paiute Tribe, Owens Valley Career Development Center, Wild Iris, and CASA of the Eastern Sierra. Participants gathered to honor the lives of children lost to abuse and neglect and to reaffirm our community's commitment to prevention.

On **April 26, 2025**, the **Superhero 5K – Racing for Heroes** took place at Bishop City Park. 45 participants preregistered, 20 attended on race day, and 7 registered on-site. Families, youth, and agency representatives participated, celebrating the message that "Every Child Deserves a Hero." The event featured free t-shirts, medals, prizes, and helping to promote positive community engagement around child safety and resilience.

Both events strengthened collaboration among community partners, raised public awareness, and reinforced the shared mission to protect and support children and families in Inyo County.


