Road Status- 09/03/2025

1. Cottonwood Rd.- **CLOSED**

Closed from the intersection Cottonwood Powerhouse Rd. (just west of HWY 395) to the end of the road.

Three different culverts, that carry Cottonwood Creek beneath the road were washed away during Storm Hilary.

Flash flooding caused extensive damage, and the dirt road was washed out in multiple areas.

No anticipated opening date currently.

2. Mesquite Valley Rd –

- **Open** towards Old Spanish Trail Rd and Charleston View.
- **Closed** towards the San Bernardino County line due to the flooding from the Storm Hilary. Numerous water crossings have been washed out. **No anticipated opening date currently.**

3. Wildrose Rd - **CLOSED**

In the Death Valley National Park, Wildrose Rd is closed due to flooding from the Storm Hilary. The road is washed out and completely impassable due to a 9-foot-deep cut across the road. The road is closed from Trona Wildrose Rd up into Rattlesnake Gulch. Please see DVNP website for more information.

4. Old Toll Rd - **CLOSED**

This road in Panamint Springs is closed from the HWY 190 to Ophir Rd due to flooding from storm Hilary. The road is completely gone in many areas. Please see DVNP for more information.

5. North Highway - **CLOSED**

This road is temporally closed from HWY 190 to Grapevine Ranger Station due to recent storm debris. It is not possible to exit this way if vehicle enters from Big Pine of Racetrack Rd. Please see DVNP for more information.
