- a. Airport Improvement Project update

RW12/30 Safety improvement project underway. Started 2 weeks ago. 12 RW end nearly complete. Fencing sub-contractor will come mid November 2025 for 1 week. December 3<sup>rd</sup> is completion goal. Beacon Project- Contractor approval complete, starting to purchase supplies/materials. Beacon will be out of service for only 1 night. Our current beacon is from WWII era. Old beacon will be saved until display for it is figured out. Board might be able to have input as to what final display looks like. Meeting with FAA regarding Airport capital improvements: Taxiway Alpha crack-fill added. FAA didn't want to pay for improvements due to 2018 Airport Layout plan for portions to be abandoned in the future. 08/26 will be closed within the next few years. Airport layout project could use some modernization and other projects in the works airport has airmarked funds for may need to be reallocated to complete projects such as possible fence work.

- b. 100 Low Lead Truck.

Truck delivered last Wednesday and is operational and has been used several times since.

- c. General Aviation at BIH

Oxygen is unavailable at KBIH even though stated available through Hanger One Aero Service. KMMH does have oxygen available through Hot Creek Aviation.
