SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT

**BETWEEN
COUNTY OF INYO
AND
INYO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION (DSA)**

This Side Letter of Agreement ("Agreement") between the County of Inyo ("County") and the Inyo County Deputy Sheriff's Association ("Association") (collectively, the "Parties") is entered into with respect to the following:

WHEREAS, Article 14, Subsection G of the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Parties addresses *Other Compensation – Instructor Pay* for employees who are certified to routinely and consistently provide training instructor to the department.

WHEREAS, Article 14, Subsection G currently authorizes up to four (4) Range Master/Firearms Instructor positions; and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize the operational need to include one (1) District Attorney Investigator position within the authorized Range Master/Firearms Instructor assignments; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to clarify the total number and allocation of Range Master/Firearms Instructor positions;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Article 14, Subsection G – Instructor Pay shall be modified as follows with respect to the Range Master/Firearms Instructor designation:

Range Master/Firearms Instructor (maximum of five (5))

Of the five (5) authorized Range Master/Firearms Instructor positions:

- Four (4) shall be Sheriff's Department employees; and
- One (1) may be a District Attorney Investigator position.

All other language in Article 14, Subsection G, including certification at the direction of the Sheriff and the five percent (5%) additional compensation provisions, shall remain unchanged.

Except as modified herein, all other wages, hours, and terms and conditions of employment listed in the 2025–2028 MOU shall remain in full force and effect until a successor agreement is reached.
