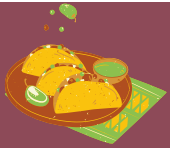

What are the differences?



## Temporary Food Facility

- Only operates at Community Events- Mule Days, Arts in the park, etc..
- Booth setup 4 walls, overhead protection, handwash/warewash stations, commissary
- Annual permit or single event permit



## Mobile Food Facility

- A trailer or a truck setup
- Can operate throughout the county with property owner permission and permits
- Commissary required
- Food manager cards & food handler cards required
- Hot water, mechanical refrigeration
- HCD Insignia required



## Compact Mobile Food Operation

- Non-motorized pushcart, can be pulled by bicycle
- Requirements are dependent on menu
- Food handler cards required
- Integrated hand wash sink



## Cottage Food Operation



- Utilizes home kitchen
- Menu is from approved Cottage Food List determined by the state
- Class A-direct selling, no inspection
- Class B-direct & indirect selling, inspection required
